

## Non-standard Circuit Entry

Non-standard circuit entries are not recommended, but may be used. The two types of non-standard entry are from base leg and straight-in. Aircraft using non-standard entries must give way to other aircraft. To conduct these procedures, you must determine the wind direction, speed and runway in use and broadcast your intentions.

**Straight-in Approaches** - You must be established on finals not less than 3 miles from the runway threshold. Furthermore, you must broadcast at 3NM and give way to traffic already in the circuit.

**Base leg entries** – You must give way to other aircraft in the circuit and ensure that the aircraft can safely join base leg applicable to the circuit direction.
